Dayton's Cookbook

Chocolate Strawberry Cake



Ingredients

Cake:

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour plus more for pans
- 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
- 3/4 cup cocoa powder
- 1/2 Tbsp baking soda
- 3/4 tsp baking powder
- 3/4 tsp salt
- 2 large eggs
- 3/4 cup buttermilk
- 1/4 cup + 1 Tbsp canola oil
- 1 1/2 tsp vanilla extract
- 2/3 cup boiling water


Frosting:

- 1 1/2 cups unsalted butter
- 4 1/2 cups confectioners sugar
- 1/2 cup fresh ripe strawberries, washed, stemmed, and hulled
- 1 1/2 tsp vanilla extract

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Butter two 9" round cake pans, and dust with extra flour, tapping out excess.
2. Sift flour, sugar, cocoa, baking soda, baking powder, and salt into the bowl of a mixer. Beat on low-speed until just combined. Increase speed to medium, and add eggs, buttermilk, oil, and vanilla. Beat until smooth, approximately 3 minutes. Turn mixer off and carefully add boiling water. Beat on high for approximately 1 minute until well-combined.
3. Divide batter evenly among pans. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes until set. Check with toothpick by inserting in the center of each cake. It should come out clean. Cool for 15 minutes on a cooling rack. Allow to cool completely before frosting and assembling.
4. To make the frosting, puree the strawberries in a food processor. Set aside.
5. Cream butter in the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment. Gradually add confectioners sugar, beating until just combined.
6. Add strawberry puree and vanilla and beat until the buttercream is light and fluffy (approximately 3-5 minutes).
7. Frost the tops of your cakes and stack on top of each other to form three layers. Add a final layer of frosting to the outside and decorate with extra strawberries if you desire.
